## **Enrichment Grants**

Dear Enrichment Grant Applicant,

Thanks to the generous support of our donors, every year we award hundreds of Enrichment Grants to lifelong learners in need. Since our earliest days, we at Road Scholar have set aside resources to ensure that lifelong learners with limited financial means would be able to attend Road Scholar learning adventures. Road Scholar Enrichment Grants help make the dream of a lifelong learning adventure a reality. They also enhance the program experience for all participants by welcoming individuals with diverse life perspectives to fully participate in our learning communities.

You can apply for an Enrichment Grant if your household income is less than 80 percent of the median household income in your state of residency. Check the enclosed table to see if you're eligible, but keep in mind that income eligibility alone doesn't guarantee an Enrichment Grant.

If you meet the income eligibility requirement, we encourage you to submit an application. It takes us between four and six weeks to review your application. The application is your chance to tell us about yourself and what the opportunity to go on a Road Scholar learning adventure would mean to you.


Pick a program in the United States you'd like to attend and use the personal statement section of the application to tell us why it inspires you and what circumstances make it difficult for you to attend without an Enrichment Grant.

If your application is approved, we'll award you an Enrichment Grant toward the cost of the program. Please read the sections on the back for important information about the application requirements and what to expect if your application is approved.

#### THE BASICS: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT ENRICHMENT GRANTS

#### Which programs are eligible for Enrichment Grants?

You can apply for an Enrichment Grant toward the cost of any program that meets all of the following criteria:

- Takes place entirely in the United States.
- Costs NO MORE than \$1,400.

#### Who can apply for an Enrichment Grant?

We accept Enrichment Grant applications from anyone who meets all of the following criteria:

- · At least 50 years of age.
- · Lives in the United States.
- Meets the eligibility requirements (see enclosed table).
- Has not been awarded an Enrichment Grant in the last two years.

#### What happens if your application is approved?

Here's how the Enrichment Grant works:

- The Enrichment Grant is applied toward the cost of the program you selected in your application.
- The amount of the Enrichment Grant will be between \$200 and \$900, determined by your household income.
- You will pay the balance of the program cost after the Enrichment Grant has been applied.
- At minimum, you will pay a \$100 deposit, no matter the program cost and amount awarded.

#### What happens if you send in an incomplete application?

To make sure your application is reviewed, please ensure it is complete.

- Your application must include the program number and date of a specific United States program that costs \$1,400 or less.
- If you are awarded an Enrichment Grant, you must apply it toward the program and date specified in your application. You cannot reserve it for a program to be selected in the future.

#### What if your plans change?

We know that in rare instances a grant recipient may have to adjust their travel plans. Here are some things to keep in mind:

- Remember: Your program deposit is non-refundable and is used to cover our costs if you have to cancel your program or transfer to another.
- If you cancel your enrollment in the program, the Enrichment Grant becomes void.
- If Road Scholar cancels your program, the Enrichment
  Grant can be transferred to another program without fees.
- If after enrollment you decide to transfer to another eligible program, the Enrichment Grant may be transferred along with the enrollment.
- Your Enrichment Grant can't be transferred to another person.

#### Is there anything the Enrichment Grant doesn't cover?

The Enrichment Grant is applied to the cost of the program only. It does not cover ...

- The cost of transportation to and from the program.
- · Any additional material costs or expenses.

# What are you expected to do when you return from your program?

When you get back from your adventure, we ask that you do a few things for us. If you fail to do the following, we may not award you an Enrichment Grant in the future.

- Complete an evaluation after the program.
- Write a thank-you letter to the donor(s) who funded your Enrichment Grant.
- Post an online review, photos and a blog. We can help you with this if you need.
- Allow Road Scholar to use your personal statement and thank-you letter when we report to donors and tell others about our Enrichment Grants.
