Here is how the Complimentary Wine Pick Up works:

1. Purchase a case of wine from any of the participating wineries at today's event and ask to use the Complimentary Wine Pick Up.
2. Upon purchase of your case of wine you will receive a receipt. Continue to enjoy the festival while your case of wine is brought to the Wine Pick Up Booth located adjacent to the festival in the parking lot. Please allow at least ½ hour for your case of wine to arrive at the Wine Pick Up Booth.
3. Present your receipt at the Wine Pick Up Booth to redeem your case of wine.

The GSWGA Things to Know...

- *For the best experience we recommend that you taste white wines before red wines and dry wines before sweet wines.*
- *As a courtesy to those waiting to sample, please refrain from using your cell phone while tasting and please step back from the winery's table once you have sampled their wines.*
- *Participating wineries do not receive any of the gate proceeds, nor are they compensated for the wines they pour as samples. The wineries share tastings of their wines so festival attendees may learn which wines they like, and make purchases to enjoy after leaving the festival.*
- *There are many wines available to taste at each festival. We encourage you to visit each of the participating wineries and discover something new. Please taste responsibly.*
