El Pueblo de Los Angeles Historical Monument Home of World Famous Olvera Street



LOS TRES REYES – Saturday, January 6, 2018 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

A celebration of the Epiphany of the Magi (visit of the Three Kings) on the 12th day following Christmas with music, a lively theatrical procession on Olvera Street and the serving of traditional *rosca de reyes*.

REDCAT MEMORIA SONORA PERFORMANCES – Sunday, January 14th & Tuesday, January 16, 2018 3:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Two performances of Salvadoran artist and activist Alexia Miranda. She brings together several other festival artists and guests to perform *Memoria Sonora*. A composed score of music and spoken word is the basis for an improvised collective work, using sound as a language of vibration and a momentarily shared consciousness.
